

## Manager's

#### Report

Welcome back to our residents who have returned for the 2022–2023 season. Please stop by the office to sign in. It is important that you let the office know when you have returned so that we can keep your location current in the computer for future mailings and correspondence. If you are currently on the e-

blast and have had a change of email please let the office staff know. If you are not currently on the e-blast and want to be please sign up at the office. This is a good way to keep up with your Association.

This will be my last season as your Manager. After 35 years as an employee of Golf Lakes I will start a new adventure July 2023. I am thankful that most of the world is back to some sense of what we knew as normal before the pandemic and looking forward to what I enjoy most about The Season at Golf Lakes, residents enjoying the activities and fellowship.

It has been another wet summer. Along with humidity comes mildew. Several homes and awnings are beginning to show signs of mildew. I try to put off letter writing concerning mildew until November or December knowing that pressure washing is one of the first things residents do upon their return to the park. Unfortunately, with such a wet summer letters will have to go out earlier.

Don't forget there is a **November 1, 2022** deadline for the park lawn mowing contracts to be returned to the office, for 2023 service. The contracts were mailed in September and is an annual contract to begin January 2023. The contract cannot be cancelled for a year. Due to billing requirements, there will be **no exceptions** to this deadline. If you are interested in another alternative to the Park Lawn Maintenance the office does have some vendors who will do individuals.

As a reminder, the guest call box entry system is used in the following manner. Your guest will pull up to the call box, find resident's name on list (by pushing the up or down arrow...if you hold the arrow down it will scroll faster) and once the resident is found push the call button. It will time out so all the guest only has time to do is identify themselves and residents push 9 on their phone to open gate. Residents can also get their code in advance to give out to your guest and they can just enter the code and when it comes up on the screen hit the call button upon arrival to the call box.

#### MORE REMINDERS:

- When the pool vendor or maintenance staff puts out the "POOL CLOSED" sign please cooperate and stay out of the pool while it is being maintained.
- Golf Lakes cannot recommend or endorse any of the outside vendors who advertise in the Banner or the Park Directory. Residents should always get two or three quotes for work they need to have done by vendors. Also, ask your neighbors if they have used the vendor you are considering.
- Golf Lakes provides free notary services to our residents at the office. Please do not ask the staff to notarize a document not signed in front of them. Calling the office ahead of time to assure the availability of a notary and witnesses is a good idea.
- The drop box outside the office on the brick post is not an outgoing mail box. This box is used only for items intended for the office. The outgoing locked mailbox is located inside the hall in the front foyer.
- The clubhouse floor has been cleaned, polished and sealed. Please do not put any tape on the floor or carpet as it pulls up the sealant and leaves glue. Cord covers can be found in Storage A if you need to cover cords to prevent tripping.
- Golf carts are not allowed in the grass or common areas. Excess parking of golf carts in the grass around the golf cart parking at clubhouse and west side of pool fence is allowed.

Your staff has accomplished many of our summer goals and are looking forward to a new season.

#### **RULE REMINDER**

#### VI. The Mobile Home Site

- Members are responsible for the overall appearance of the mobile site. Sites shall be kept orderly, neat, clean and free of litter. Watering, weeding, replacement of lawn by sod, grass seed, plugs, mulch or stones and general care of the lawn, planters, shrubs and trees are the responsibility of the member. No lawn shall be mowed before 7:30 a.m. or on Sunday.
- 10. Mobile home sites not maintained to standards to the Association will be maintained by the Association. A minimum fee of \$50.00 will be charged to the member for each service performed.

Transylvania's Moosnick Museum

**Transylvania University's Moosnick Medical and Science Museum** in Lexington, KY displays a portion of the University's extensive holdings of nineteenth-century science artifacts, anatomical models, and botanical paintings that were used to teach the principles of physics, chemistry, and biology. The instruments were purchased in London and Paris from 1820 to about 1850 and brought to Transylvania, where they were used extensively by the students in Transylvania's flourishing medical school, which turned out thousands of doctors.

A hairball is the most famous artifact in this little-known collection at Transylvania University. The brown orb is as big as a birthday balloon and was pulled from a cow's stomach in 1848. It was donated to the University by Abraham Lincoln's brother-in-law.

The school closed in 1859 – in part because little Lexington had relatively few dead bodies to dissect – then it became an Army hospital and burned during the Civil War. Its priceless teaching tools – including weird electrical instruments, preserved body parts, unsettling anatomical models, countless dead animals, and the hairball (which appears to be lightly scorched) – were rescued from the flames. Then they disappeared into Lexington's closets, cellars, and attics.

Dr. Jamie Day, professor of physics, is caretaker/curator of the Moosnick Museum. He reports that because the relics were not thrown away, and by the time the collection was reassembled at the University in the 1920s, they were recognized as historical and worthy of display. A visiting specialist from the Smithsonian Institution judged Transylvania's collections to be among the finest in the nation for this time period.

The Moosnick Museum's artifacts are currently displayed in multiple campus locations. Dr. Day says that the University has intended since the 1940s to consolidate the collection into a single "museum" space, but its vast size and a lack of funds has continually thwarted those plans. "We have lots and lots of weird things," says Day.

The museum is located at 300 N. Broadway Road in Lexington, KY on the campus of Transylvania University. Currently, tours to see the artifacts are by appointment only and reserved for those in medicine or research.

#### MEN'S MONDAY MORNING GOLF LEAGUE Greens of Manatee - Fall 2022



The fall season of the Monday morning Men's Golf League starts with a meeting in the **Golf Lakes Clubhouse at 8:30 AM on October 31st**. The purpose of the meeting is to elect officers, confirm rules, meet and greet new players and collect dues (\$15 covers fall & winter league play). League play will start November 7th. As in the past, the first tee time will be at 8:30. It is recommended that you arrive at least 10 to 15 minutes ahead of your scheduled tee time. On some Mondays, the league play is able to start early.

Remember to sign up on Board 1 in the Clubhouse. Sheets will be posted to sign up as an individual golfer, as a 2-man team or you can sign up as a substitute. Prior to the start of league play on the 7<sup>th</sup>, a schedule for the fall season will be posted on Board 1 in the Clubhouse. In addition, each player will receive their own schedule starting on the 7<sup>th</sup>.
